Post pandemic the issue of mental health has become a consideration that can no longer be denied. The Australian Bureau of Statistics estimates that 43.7% of the population 16-85 have now experienced a mental disorder. WHY STUDY HYPNOSIS?

In psychotherapy today there is a very strong movement towards the **inclusion of trance** inducing techniques because they tend to facilitate change when talking about an issue consciously, even repetitively, simply doesn't always move the dial. Now, a finer distinction. **Not all Hypnosis is the same**. Some of it is little more than guided visualisation. Some forms are entwined with psycho-dynamic approaches, and others with modern mindfulness. Each has its own efficacy and its own devotees, but all of these approaches involve trance and deal with unconscious processes

Modern Strategic Hypnotherapy is considered by many to be **the quiet revolution in psychotherapy.** It essentially comes from the **same source points** as Cognitive Behaviour Therapy (CBT), Acceptance and Commitment Therapy (ACT) Mindfulness, Psychoneuroimmunology, Neuro-Linguistics, and Ericksonian Hypnosis.

Each of these approaches has empirical support, but when combined, the results can be spectacular. In fact, even when students are already a talk therapist of some kind, they are often **genuinely astounded** by what they see.

It is that reliable.





I can get a diploma from many schools cheaper than IAP. Why would I choose you?

These new standards for the field were written by Gordon Young at the behest of the peak body. (Hypnotherapy Council of Australia)

As you can probably imagine, this means that there is a **wide range of expertise and course quality** out there. We suggest you do your homework and really **investigate** your potential trainer. Remember, a trainer cannot give you what they do not have themselves. We have retrained many students who have frequently remarked that there is a stark difference between what we do, and what they have learned before. In many cases, they have to **unlearn** what they have learned elsewhere to become effective.

This course is a government recognised course, and as such, is **almost universally accepted around the world**. We have graduates in Europe, the UK, the USA, Canada, Singapore, Hong Kong, Pakistan New Zealand and the UAE. You can also check our credibility on **training.gov.au**

What makes this course different from other schools?

What if I cannot attend every day?

I have studied different forms of hypnosis before. How will this be different?

We recognise that there are other versions. What we also know is that our approach to psychotherapy (what we do when the client is in trance) is different from anything you have seen before. Our **trademarked**Gordian Pillars offer a simple framework for understanding and addressing most issues that a

Hypnotherapist will deal with in their practice. Dr Bill Herfel of the University of Newcastle believes that

Gordian Therapy will be "the next big thing" once more people are exposed to it.

Milton Erickson is arguably the **most influential figure** in modern psychotherapy and coaching since Freud, and is considered the father of modern hypnotherapy. Gordon learned many of his methods from Erickson's direct students (Erickson passed away in 1980). Learning a form of hypnosis closer to the source meant the lessons were less diluted than many other offerings. We, and many others, believe this is a **more authentic** form of Ericksonian Hypnosis.

Its a good question. Not everyone is cut out to be a hypnotherapist, or a therapist of any kind. So lets lay it
out for you. Can you say yes to at least 8 of the 11 the boxes below?

☐ Do you have life experience and have you successfully overcome challenges along the way?
☐ Do you want to make a difference in people's lives?
☐ Are you interested/fascinated by the mind and human potential?
☐ Do you have the ability to learn a practical skill?
☐ Do you have compassion for people?
☐ Can you park your own judgement and biases and help someone?
☐ Can you maintain decent boundaries so the client's problems don't start to feel like they are yours?
Do you want to create your own life and your own enterprise?
☐ Are you an independent thinker who knows your own mind?
☐ Can you read and absorb information at a Australian High School Certificate Level.

I have not studied in years. How do I know I can complete the course?

This is a common concern. You do need basic computer skills, there is no getting around that. However, this is vocational training and is therefore not an "academic" course. Our focus is practical applications of knowledge. If you have barely read anything outside of a menu in the last 20 years, you will probably take some time to get into the groove, but you do have a full 12 months to complete the course, and there are no other deadlines, so it is completely self paced.

Moreover, when people ask, "How do I know if I will complete the course", what they are really saying is that they don't TRUST themselves to maintain the effort. They are struggling with the uncertainty of the future, but whether they complete or not is within their control. If you do what it takes to succeed, you will succeed. There is no special secret. It is not attached to your self worth. **Follow the steps**, and get the outcome!

Our form of hypnosis is all about **empowering people**, which often translates into helping them get out of their own way. If you **need help** in this area, you can work on it during our practical sessions.

Can I do this course when I am working full time?

Most of our students are working full-time, and ironically, tend to finish before those who are not working at all. Do you need to be **organised**? Yes! Do you need to make time? Yes! Do you need to be **self motivated**? Yes! It may be a challenge at times, but the reward is the **potential to create your life** the way you want, free of many of the pressures you have now. Previous students would attest, it is totally worth it. Hypnotherapy is a **deeply satisfying career**. You get to see people transform in just a few sessions and you get to feel like you truly make a difference. It is a privilege that most people will never have.

Is hypnotherapy a good choice for me compared to other modalities?

If your preference is to engage in weekly discussions with a client and essentially provide ongoing "support" more than facilitate change, this form of hypnotherapy is probably not for you. If you want to be a brief therapist (anything under 20 sessions is considered brief therapy) and are **results-driven**, the answer is yes. If you don't have three to six years to go back to university to qualify, the answer absolutely is yes.
